## LAB SAFETY RULES

- 1. There may be no eating or drinking in the laboratory. No food containers or water bottles are allowed on lab benches.
- 2. Keep aisles free of backpacks and purses.
- 3. Keep lab benches free of any materials not needed for experiment.
- 4. Familiarize yourself with the location of the fire extinguisher and the emergency telephone.
- 5. Wear safety goggles and gloves for all experiments involving chemicals (noted on your syllabus).
- 6. Familiarize yourself with the location of the broken glassware container.
- 7. Do not use damaged glassware.
- 8. Discard broken glass or damaged glassware in the container marked for this purpose.
- 9. Notify your lab Instructors of spills and then clean up spills immediately and thoroughly with plenty of soap and water. Rinse any used sponges thoroughly.
- 10. Flush any chemicals that come into contact with your skin or eyes immediately and thoroughly with water and then notify your lab instructor.
- 11. Long hair must be tied back, and loose sleeves and hanging jewelry secured.
- 12. Dispose of any biohazardous materials in biohazard waste containers.
- 13. Do not pour volatile chemicals into sinks. The instructional lab technician will handle their disposal.
- 14. You must wear closed shoes. NO SANDALS ALLOWED.
