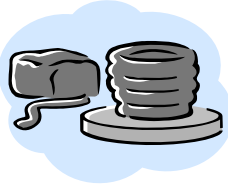


Outline of lesson (2-5 grade)



Indicators for Archaeology and Art

Students will learn about the basics of archaeology.
Students will demonstrate an understanding of artifacts and ecofacts.
Students will learn about archaeology in Maryland.
Students will be able to recognize and use different methods of adding texture to pottery.

Day 1

- What is an archaeologist?
- Jigsaw activity
- Site in a bag activity (classifying items found in bag as artifact or eco fact)

Day 2

- Archaeology and Pottery PowerPoint
Presentation: Maryland Native Americans and Pottery styles during the Woodland period.
- Begin Pottery lesson (see lesson plan)

Day 3

- Class gallery walk
- Students will pair up and discuss their coil pots in terms of the Art Elements and the Principles of Design.
