How to Search for Honors Courses

Honors courses at Montgomery College are designated as follows:

- Courses with an HC suffix are honors sections (e.g. ENGL 102HC). An honors section of a course has fewer seats than its non-honors counterparts and all students in the section are honors students.
- Courses with an HM suffix are honors modules (e.g. MATH 181HM). An honors module is attached to a regular section of the same course. Students registered for the HM are also in the regular section that the HM is attached to. Honors modules have between 1 and 5 seats.
- Courses with an HONR prefix are honors seminars (e.g. HONR 101AA). An honors seminar is a general elective course and all students in the seminar are honors students.

Notes:

- Students should read the section notes for honors courses for eligibility requirements. Some honors courses are offered by a specific honors program at Montgomery College, such as <u>Renaissance Scholars</u> or <u>Montgomery Scholars</u> and registration is limited to students in those programs.
