1. Proposals should include a clear title, an abstract (not exceeding 250 words), and a brief presenter bio (s).
2. Presentations can be individual sessions, panel discussions, workshops, or roundtable discussions.
3. Each proposal should provide a detailed session outline, including crucial objectives and interactive elements.
4. Proposals should demonstrate originality, relevance to the conference theme, and potential impact on the audience.
5. Presenters are encouraged to incorporate interactive activities, case studies, and practical strategies into their sessions.

SUBMISSION PROCESS:

Please [submit your proposal](#) by March 13, 2026. Proposals will undergo a blind review process by our conference review committee. Successful applicants will be notified of their acceptance by March 27, 2026.
