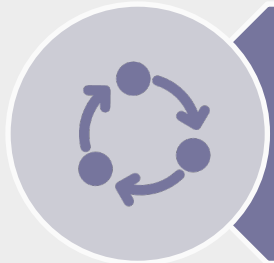

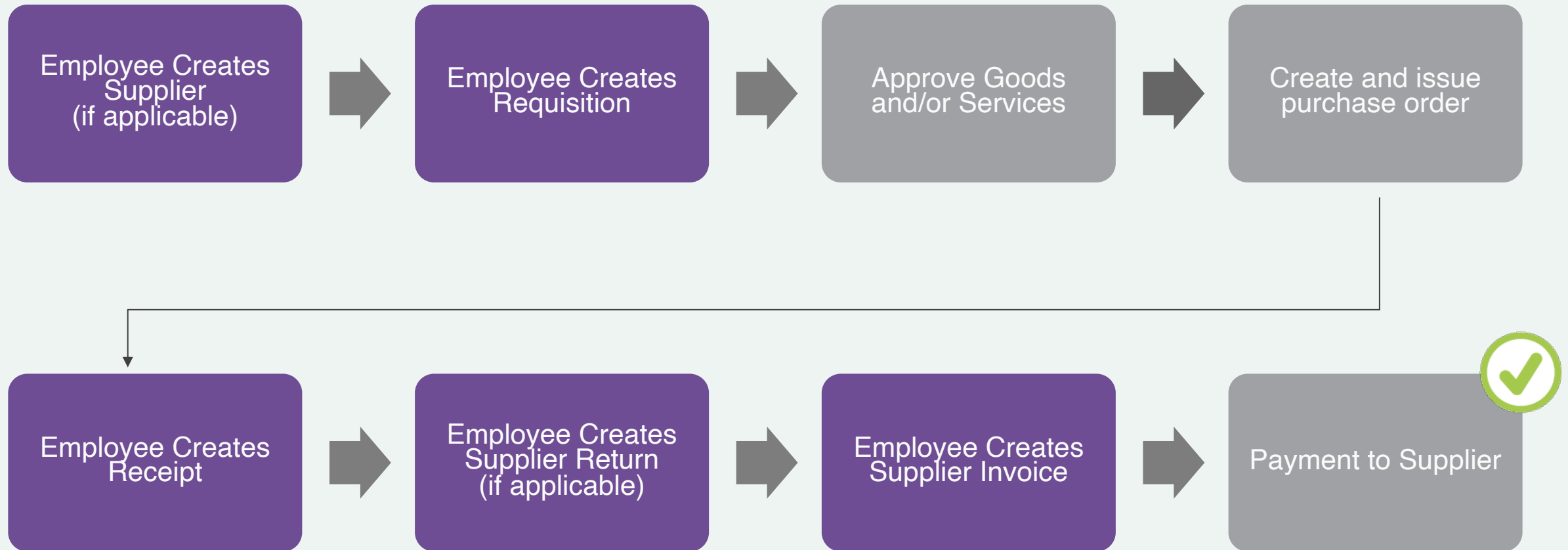

Process Flow: Procure-to-Pay



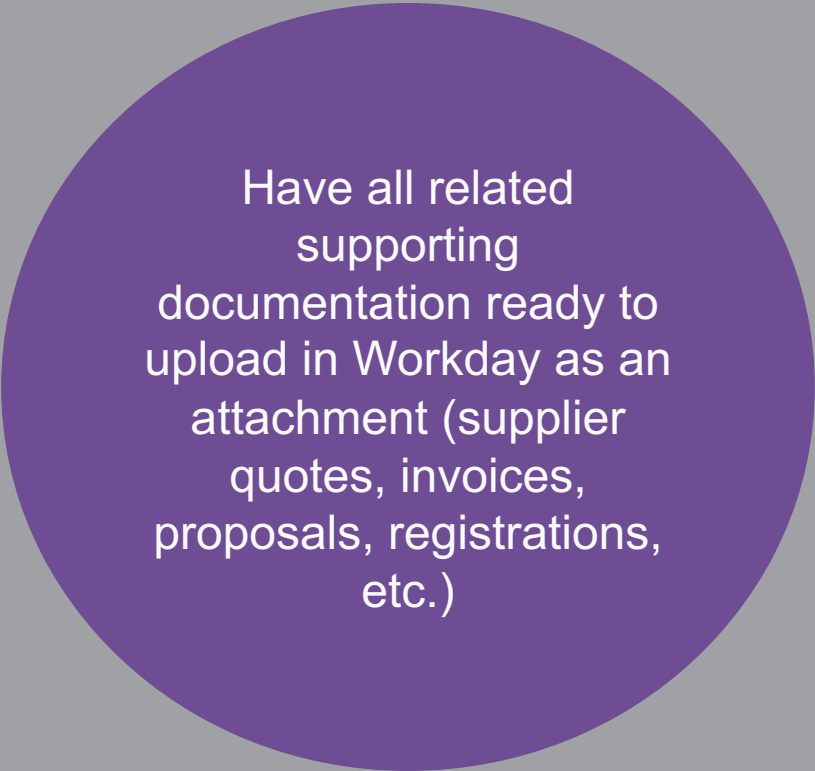
Procure-to-Pay Terms to Know

Banner Term	Workday Term	Definition
Requisition	Requisition	Transaction to request goods or services
Purchase Order	Purchase Order	External transaction to request goods or services from suppliers
Vendor	Supplier	Vendor that provides goods or services
Vendor Invoice	Supplier Invoice	Workday transaction that accrues liability and generates a payment to the supplier
Requisitioner	Initiator/Requestor	Worker requesting the good or service
Purchasing Agent	Buyer	Worker who sources the requisition to a PO and “owns” the PO from the supplier’s perspective

Requisitions Overview

Procurement Requisition

- Request from your department to procurement to procure goods or services you need



Have all related supporting documentation ready to upload in Workday as an attachment (supplier quotes, invoices, proposals, registrations, etc.)

Employee Self-Service for Procurement

Overview of Key Changes

Previously	Workday Starting 1/3/2022
Procurement Requisitions were completed in Banner.	Procurement Requisitions completed in Workday.
Banner activity codes were entered on certain transactions.	Now Worktags are required on certain transactions.
Receiving Department created the return to supplier.	Employee/Requestor of goods/services creates the Return to Supplier.
Attachments for requisitions were uploaded to Image Now (Perceptive Content).	Attachments for requisitions are uploaded directly into Workday when entering a requisition.

Procurement Worktags to know

Keywords assigned to each transaction to indicate its College purpose

Used to accurately categorize, classify, and aggregate transactions

Cost Center, Fund, Grant, Program, and Spend Category are worktags you should know prior to initiating a procurement requisition

Banner Term	Workday Term	Description
Organization	Cost Center/ Specialization	Represents “where” revenue or costs are being recorded. Cost Centers are generally used to identify departmental budgets and typically identify defined business segments. Note: A Specialization is a sub-division of a Cost Center based on department’s needs.
Fund Code	Fund/Agency/Auxiliary	Defines College activities restricted, unrestricted, and fund reserved for plant projects. Funds are also used to group related activities for financial statement and budget management purposes. Note: Agency Funds and Auxiliary Services are sub-divisions of funds in Workday. Allowed Funds are assigned to each Cost Center, Grant and Project.
Grant/Foundation Fund and/or Activity Code	Grant	Used to track the activities of the College’s externally funded grants associated with an award. Note: For AELG it is determined from Fund + Activity. For Foundation grant to the College, it is determined based on Activity. For everything else, it is determined from Fund.
Program	Program/Discipline	Functional Classification used to track operating expenses for financial statement reporting. Allowed Programs & Disciplines are assigned to each Cost Center, Grant, and Project. Note: Program will default based on the Cost Center. Discipline is only used for Instructional Program 1000.
Account Code	Spend Category	Used to organize, track, and report on College expenses. It represents detailed expense being recorded. Expense items are associated with specific spend categories. Note: This dimension is required for all expense transactions.

Banner-to-Workday Crosswalk Query Report

If you need to locate the previous Banner FOAPA (Fund, Organization, Account, Program, Activity) value and what the value is now called in Workday, use the Banner-to-Workday Crosswalk Query report

Banner-to-Workday Crosswalk Query

Instructions This report allows you to enter Banner FOAPA values to retrieve the corresponding Workday worktags. You can enter multiple values (Fund, Org, Account, Program and Activity) at the same time, or you may enter one or more of the values and leave the other fields blank. When entering the Banner FOAPA values, it is required that you include the Banner chart (letter) as a prefix for each Banner FOAPA value entered. Banner chart values are listed below. The same prefix letter must be included for each FOAPA value entered when running the report.

Montgomery College (MC) Chart = M
Foundation Chart = F
PicMC Chart = S

Examples:
Montgomery College
Fund 1110 would be entered as M1110
Org 226000 would be entered as M226000
Account 6091 would be entered as M6091
Program 2000 would be entered as M2000
Activity F22131 would be entered as MF2213

Foundation
Fund 1110 would be entered as F1110
Org 00 would be entered as F00
Account 6010 would be entered as F6010
Program TA would be entered as FTA
Activity F501TK would be entered as FF501TK

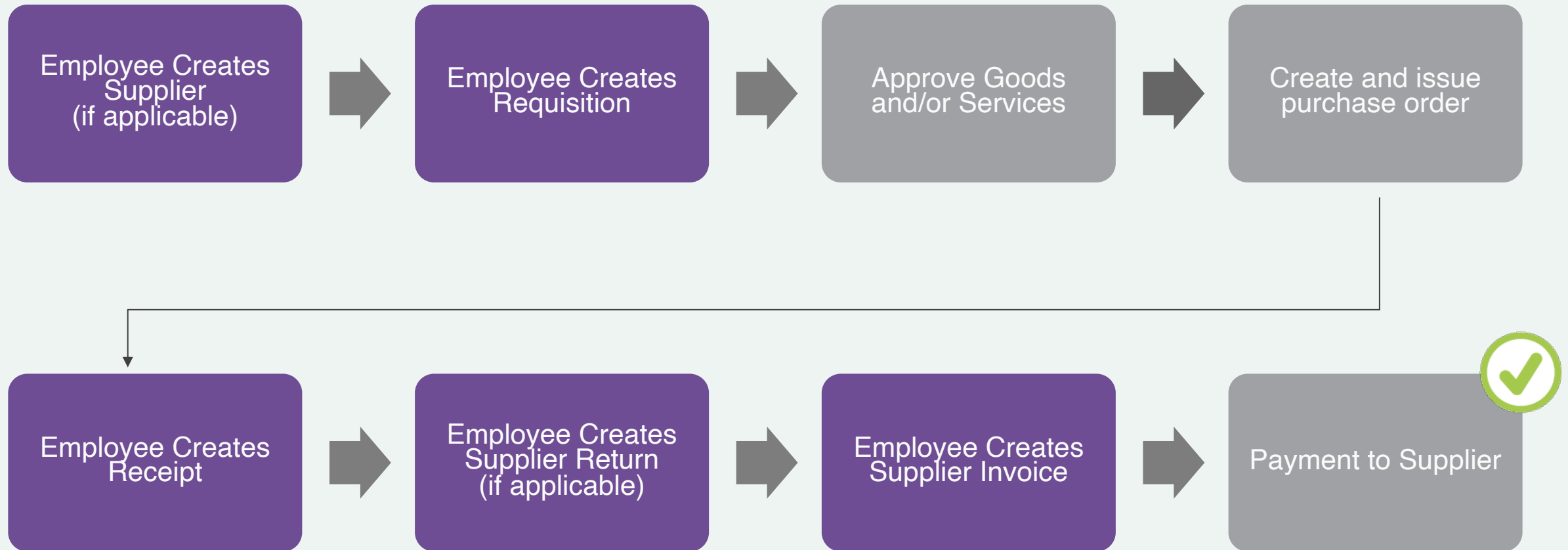

Org 1000 would be entered as S1000
Account 6091 would be entered as S6091
Program 99 would be entered as S99
(Activity is not applicable to Chart S)

AELG Grants
AELG grant translations for Banner Activity requires the inclusion of both Banner chart and Banner fund values as prefixes for the Banner Activity value. A hyphen (with spaces on both sides) is also required between the fund and activity values. For example, to translate Banner Activity CCFCC used with Banner fund 22962A, the Banner Activity code should be entered as:

M22962A – CCFCC

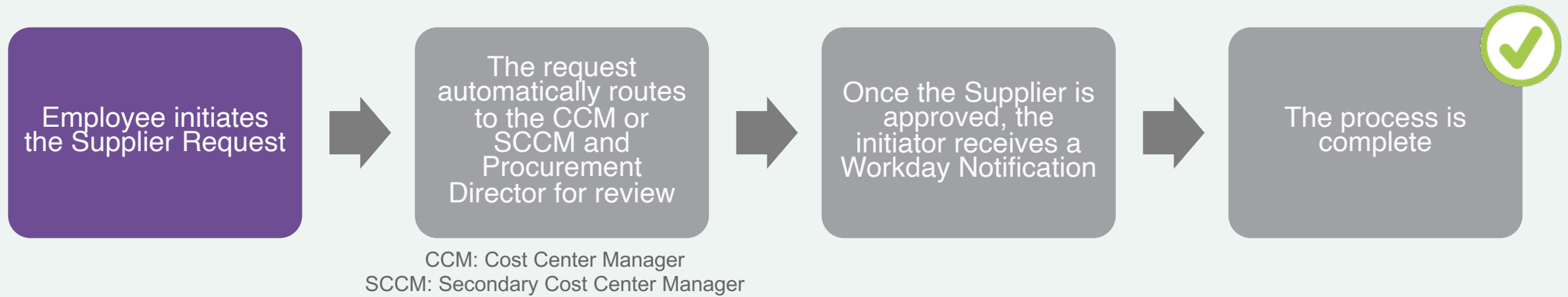
Process Flow: Procure-to-Pay



Create Supplier Request

- If the Supplier does not exist in Workday, then a Supplier Request must be created
- The supplier's W-9 form and Tax ID are required to upload
- The supplier request automatically routes to the Cost Center Manager and then to the Procurement Director for Approval

- 1. Search and select **Create Supplier Request** from the Workday search bar.
- 2. Enter the **Supplier Name**, **Supplier Category**, **Tax ID**, & **Justification** (if applicable).

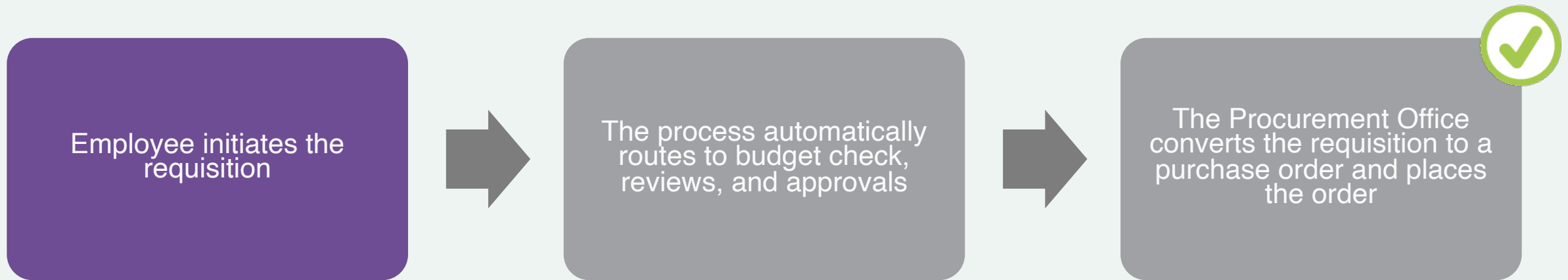

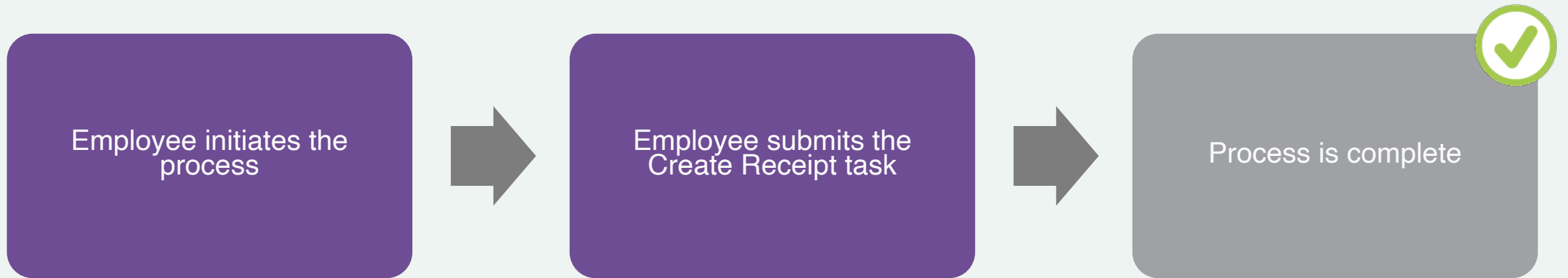

Create Receipt

- Once the Buyer has Issued the Purchase Order, and the Good(s) and/or Services have been received, then the Employee who requested the Good(s) and/or Service(s) can Create a Receipt
- A packing slip or other related package documentation is required and must be attached in Workday
- Any items received after June 30th will be charged to the next FY budget
- You may edit the receipt after submission
 - View the *Create Receipt* job aid for guidance

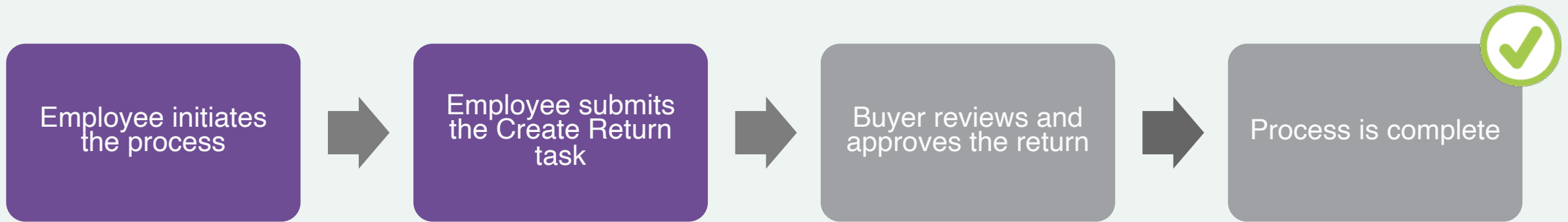

Create Return to Supplier

- The requestor of the goods/services creates the return to supplier if an item needs to be returned
- New process for MC employees

Create Supplier Invoice Request (DIRECT PAY)

- Should be used when the Department has received an invoice from a supplier for goods or services that they have purchased and received
- For goods, the maximum amount is up to \$4,999 (for a single unit/item), and for services it is up to \$10,000.
- If the supplier is not listed, you must submit a supplier request and wait for confirmation that the supplier has been added

1. Search and select **Create Supplier Invoice Request** from the Workday search bar.
2. Modify the **Invoice Date**, if necessary.
3. Enter the **Company**, **Supplier**, and **Supplier's Invoice Number**. **Currency** will default.

Create Supplier Invoice Request

4. In the Lines Section, select **Goods Line** or **Services Line**.
5. Select an **Item** if it is listed.
6. Enter an **Item Description**.
7. Select a **Spend Category** if not automatically populated.
8. Select the **Quantity** and specify the **Unit Cost**. Together these calculate the extended amount.
9. Select the **Cost Center**.

Create Supplier Invoice Request

- 10. From the top right corner, click **Splits** if the invoice request line is being split across multiple cost centers or projects.
- 11. Enter either the **Percent** or **Amount** you wish to split by.
- 12. Enter a **Memo, Cost Center, Fund, & Program**.
- 13. Click the **Attachments** tab and drag-and-drop supporting documentation.
- 14. Click **Submit**.

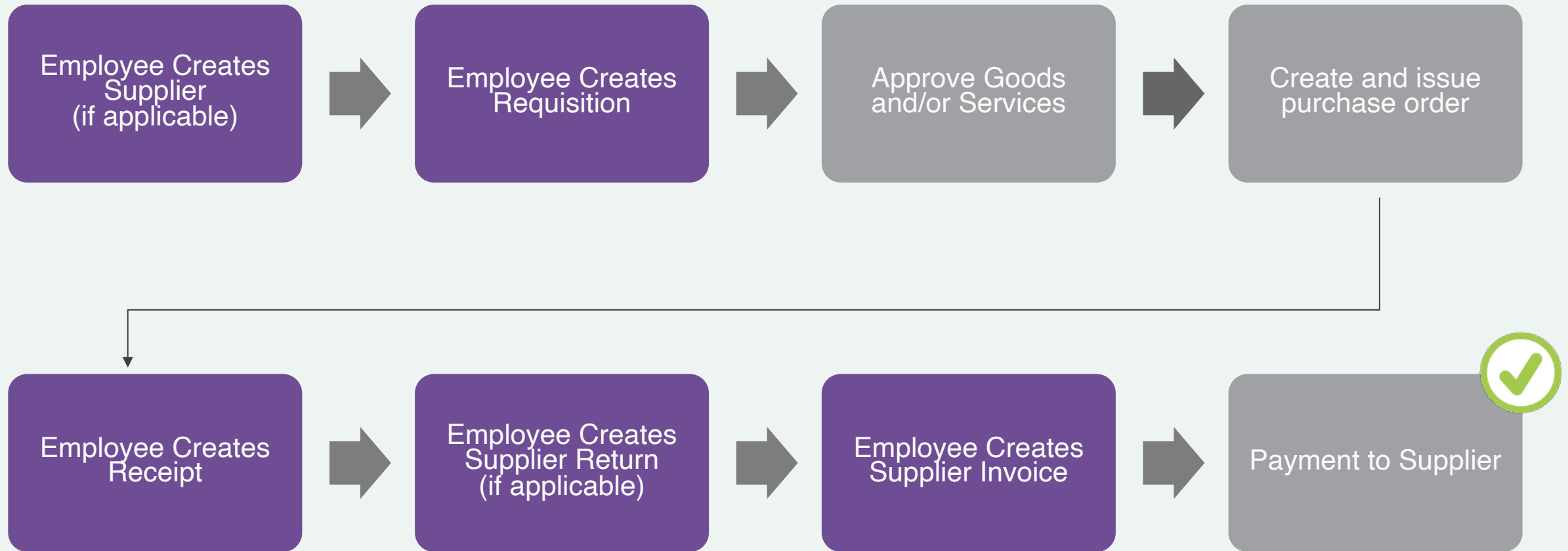

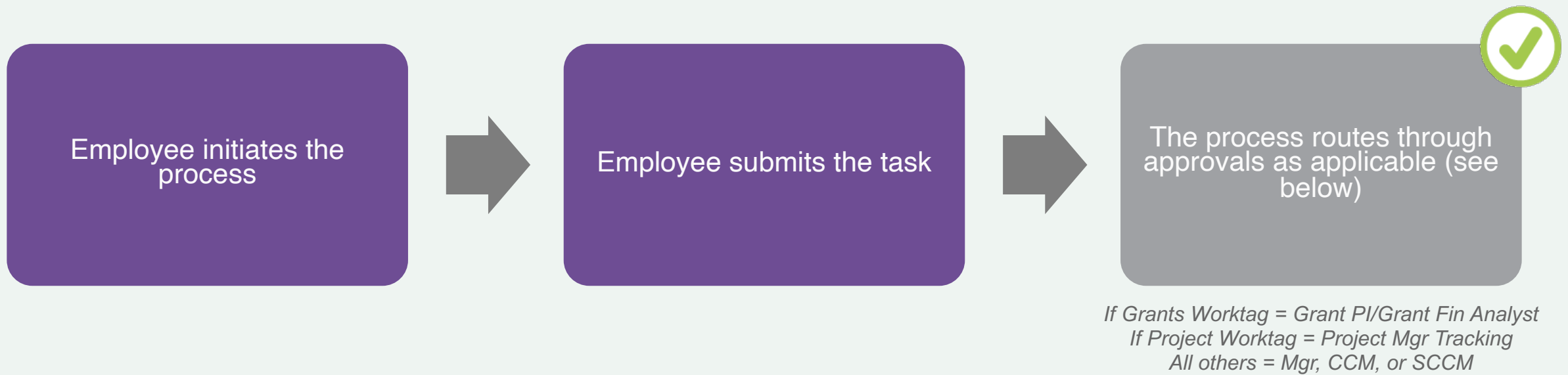
Process Flow: Procure-to-Pay



Verify P-Card Transaction

- P-Card transactions will now be reconciled directly in Workday (Replaces expense reporting using Centre Suite)
- The purpose of this process is to ensure that credit card spend can be commercially validated and assigned with data for posting in the General Ledger and payment recording
- Employees will be encouraged to verify p-card transactions on a daily or weekly basis depending on volume
- All p-card transactions must be verified in Workday before the 10th day of the month for the previous month's transactions

Process Flow: Verify P-Card Transaction



Verify P-Card Transaction

1. Search and select **Verify Procurement Card Transactions** from the Workday search bar.
2. Review your P-Card Transactions in the grid. Check the box next to the applicable transaction or click **Select All**. Click **OK**.
3. In the Transaction Details section, enter a **Line Item Description**, **Spend Category**, **Quantity**, **Unit of Measure**, & **Unit Cost**.
4. Upload required attachments (receipt) and click **Submit**.
