THE PURPOSE OF ADDENDUM IS TO <u>MAKE CHANGES, AND PROVIDE ANSWERS TO THE REQUEST FOR</u> <u>CLARIFICATIONS</u> TO THE RFP DOCUMENTS.

Please make following change to the RFP documents.

Item 3-1 <u>To correct</u> the item sequence numbers in Part 4.2 & Part 4.3 on the Price Proposal Form issued under Addendum No. 2. Price Proposal has been re-issued in its entirety for Offeror's convenience. Please use this form for price proposal submission.

The following items offer clarification that <u>do not change</u> the requirements of the RFP documents.

Item 3-2	Question:	Please clarify if there are existing controls/BAS Systems that the new mechanical work will need to be tied in with, additionally if there is a current system that is to be tied into, please provide information regarding this system.
	<u>Answer:</u>	No new mechanical work is being provided under this project. Mechanical sheets reference cleaning and balancing of existing equipment only. No Control modifications are required. For reference, all existing mechanical equipment is controlled by the existing BAS.
Item 3-3	<u>Question:</u>	Please confirm all work associated with the salvaging/installation of the existing card readers is to be performed by the owners third party Low Voltage contractor as it was discussed that the GC is to provide pathways/ "Ring and String" only for low voltage work.
	Answer:	Contractor should remove existing card readers and turn over to the College.
ltem 3-4	<u>Question:</u>	Please confirm that the work that is to be performed off hours is only the work that is deemed disruptive to ongoing classes and not the entire project scope.
	Answer:	Correct.
ltem 3-5	<u>Question:</u>	Please confirm that an allowance for any sprinkler work is to be incorporated into this project for all bidders.
	Answer:	A \$5,000 allowance requirement is included in Addendum #2.
ltem 3-6	Question:	Please confirm that all AV/Telecom work is to be performed by the owners third party low voltage contractor.

<u>Answer:</u> Yes, contractor to provide back boxes and conduits with string.



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- Item 3-7 Please confirm that knock down frames will be acceptable for the new door frames in lieu of Question: welded frames per the discussions on site. Yes, this is what was discussed on site, but qualified with only if welded frames were not Answer: feasible to bring up the elevator or difficult to coordinate with existing walls. Note also that knock-down frames are addressed in Specification Section 081213 Hollow Metal Frames, see Sheet AR.100. Item 3-8 Please confirm that BIM modeling requirements are to be waived on this project per Question: discussions at the site visit on 12/20/2022. Refer to Addendum #2. Answer: Item 3-9 A. 103. Please clarify if the general contractor is to furnish the dimensional letter signage as Question: the drawings state on A.103 that the existing raised letter signage at Room 301 is to be salvaged and the specification on AR.101 states "Text is to be provided by MC" which we had interpreted as GC furnished based on the lettering that MC wants to have. Contractor to salvage existing raised letter and reinstall at another location at Owner's Answer: direction. The College will provide and install new signage. Item 3-10 Question: Please clarify if there is ample attic stock available for the Acoustical Panel Ceilings per Specification 095113 on AR.101 as the spec notes to secure materials from owner's attic stock OR to provide new. If new tiles will be required, please provide product information on the existing tiles as only the Ceiling Grid information is provided in this spec. The College does not have ceiling tile info. Contractor to provide best matches for Design Answer: Team review and approval. Item 3-11 Question: Please clarify where Note 16 on Drawings AD.100 – AD.103 applies to this project as this I cannot locate this note callout nor an additional Alternate on the bid form as the note specifies that this is an "Alternate Scope" and the only alternate listed is for Room (Lounge) 309. Additionally, Note 16 states there is to be a new storefront door however, the only
