

## Pregnancy

In accordance with Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, Title IX prohibits discrimination on the basis of sex, including pregnancy and related conditions. The College must give all students who might be, are, or have been pregnant the same access to school programs and educational opportunities as other students.

Students who are pregnant, have recently given birth, or are experiencing related conditions (including miscarriage, abortion, or recovery) are entitled to reasonable accommodations to ensure equal access to the College's educational program and activities. Examples of available accommodations include:

- Excused absences for medical appointments or recovery
- Flexibility with assignment deadlines and class participation
- Access to lactation spaces
- Opportunities to make up missed work or exams

*Please note: This list is not exhaustive. The Title IX team can provide additional accommodations as needed that are available under the Title IX regulations.*

You are not required to disclose pregnancy or other personal medical information to faculty or staff, except at your own discretion.
