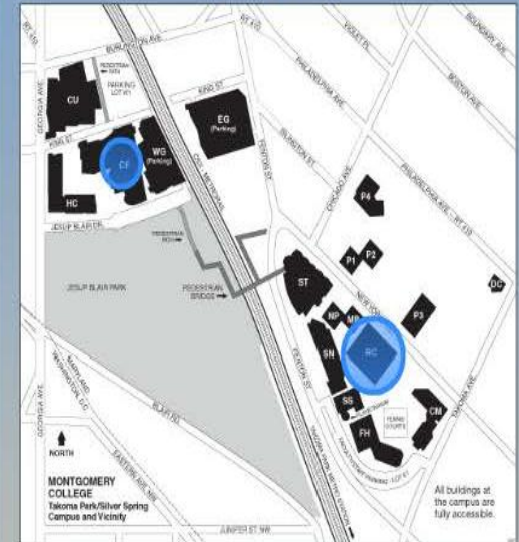

Main Library RC 1st Floor

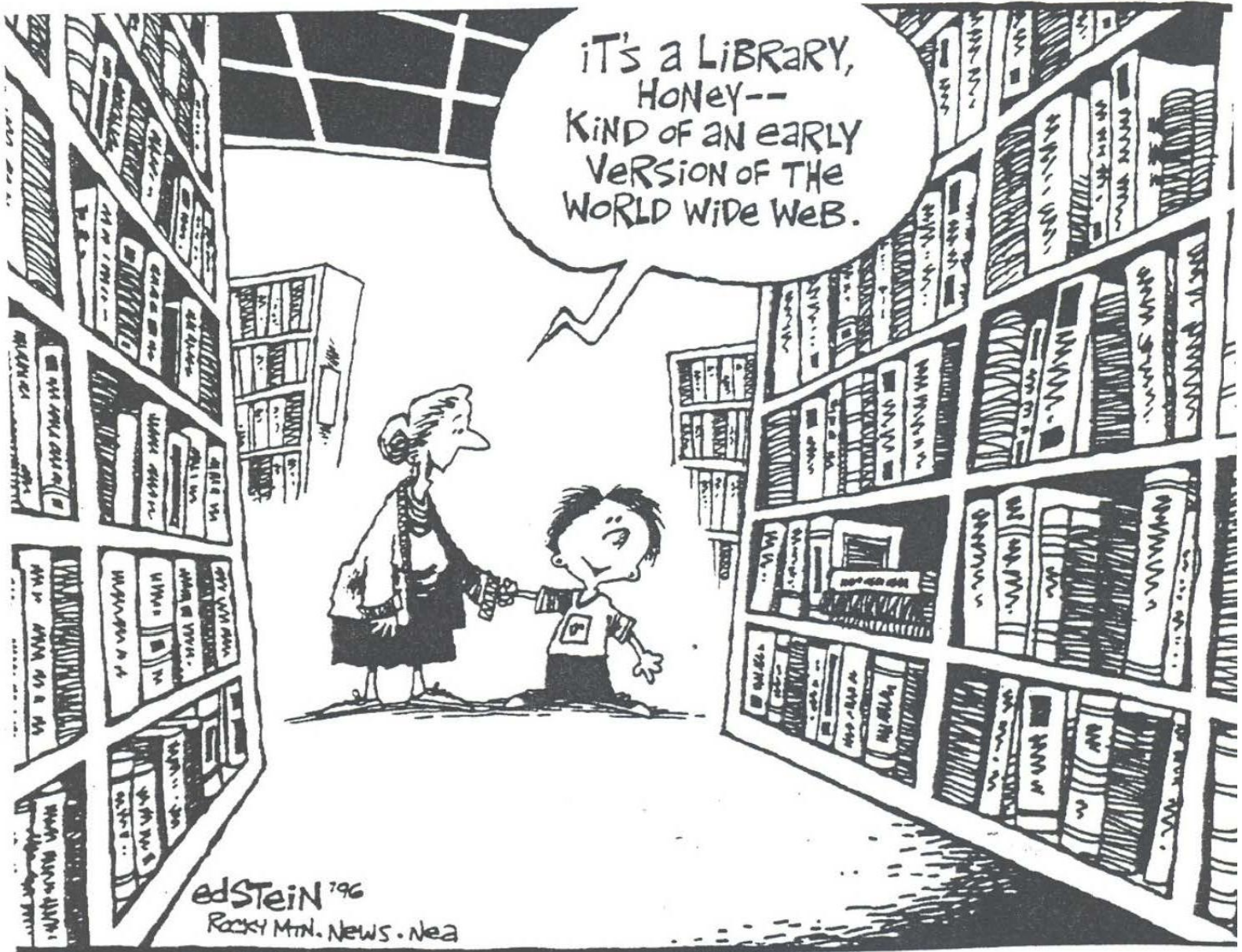

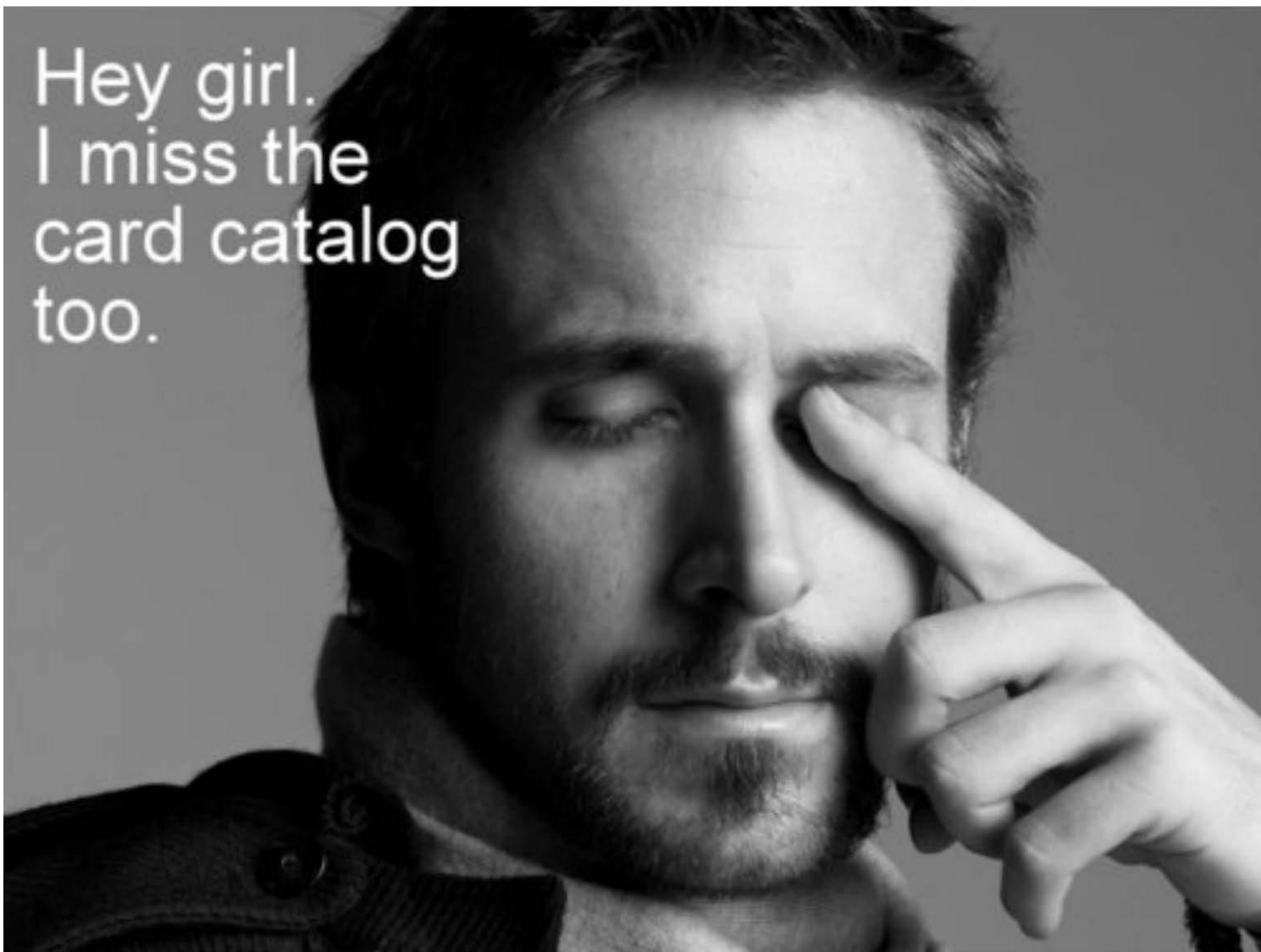
- The Libraries welcome faculty suggestions for books, films, periodicals, and databases.

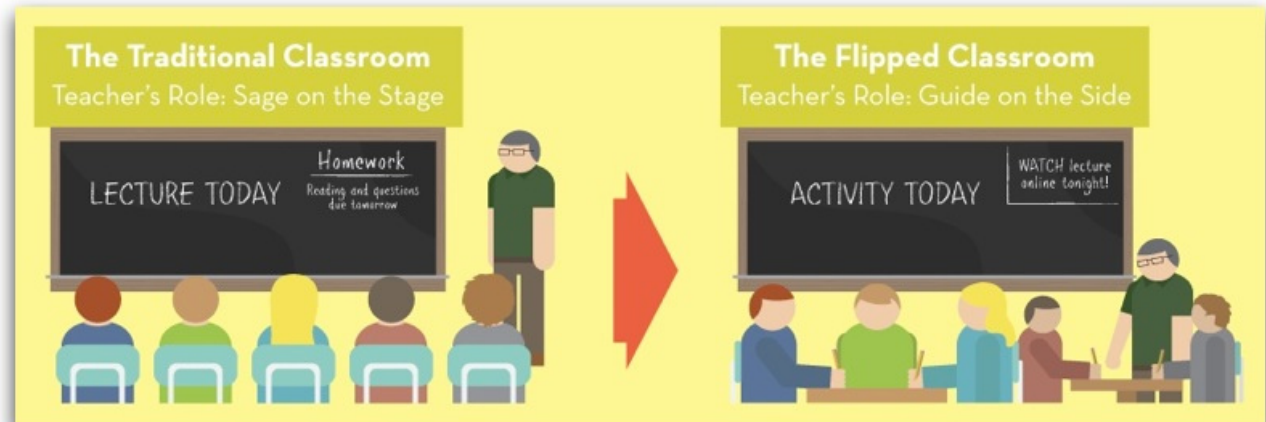

KNOW – ACCESS – EVALUATE – USE – ETHICS

Within each standard, there are several specific learning outcomes and proficiency measures. The Libraries' tutorials are aligned with individual outcomes within each of the five standards.

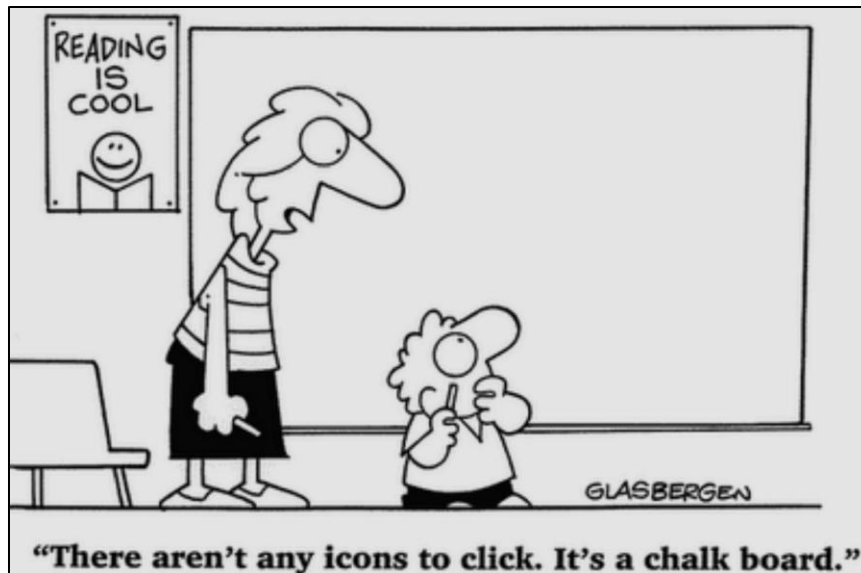

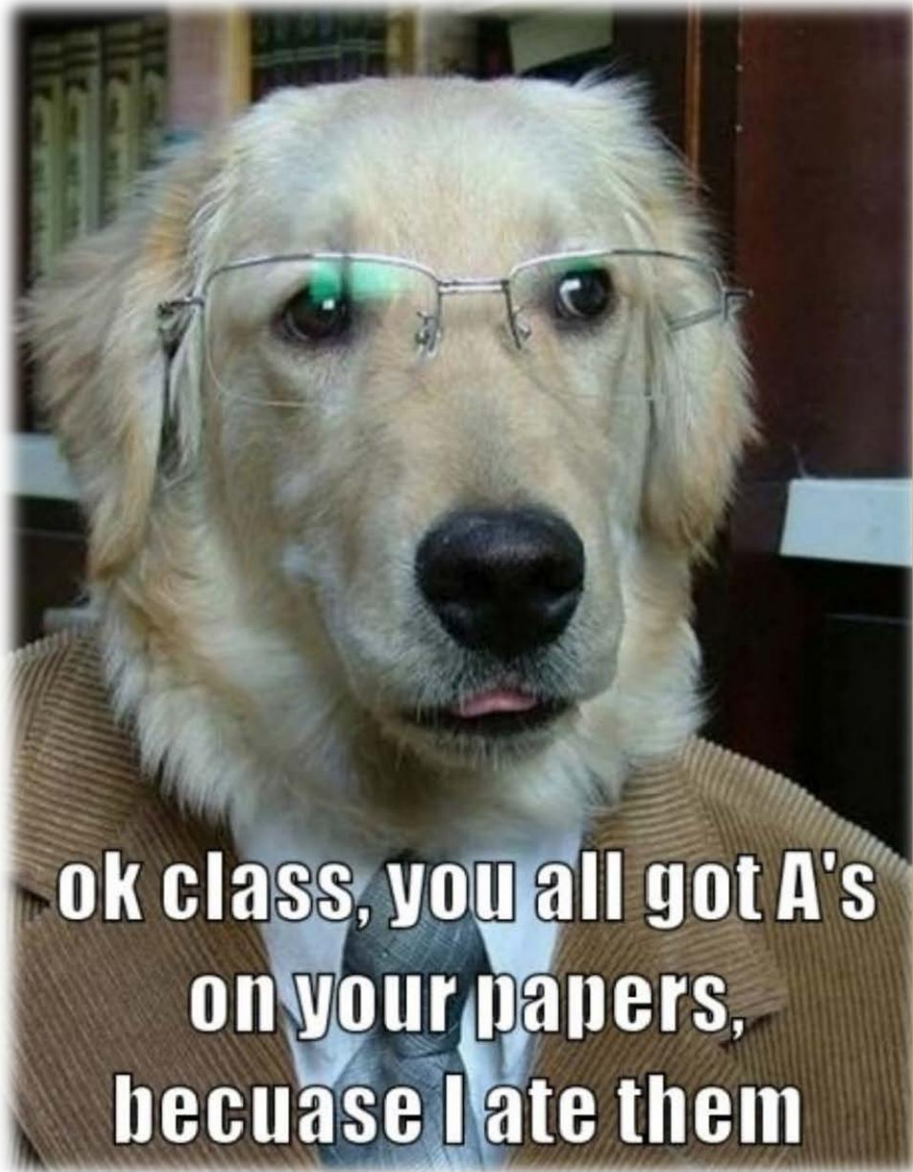

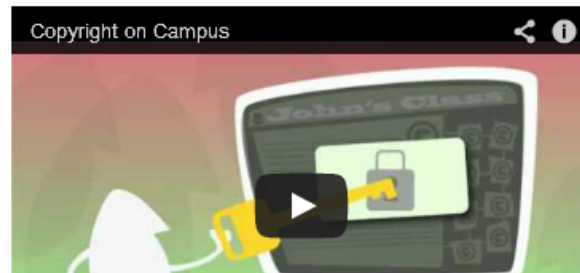

- ePortfolio labs are open at RV and TP/SS campus libraries

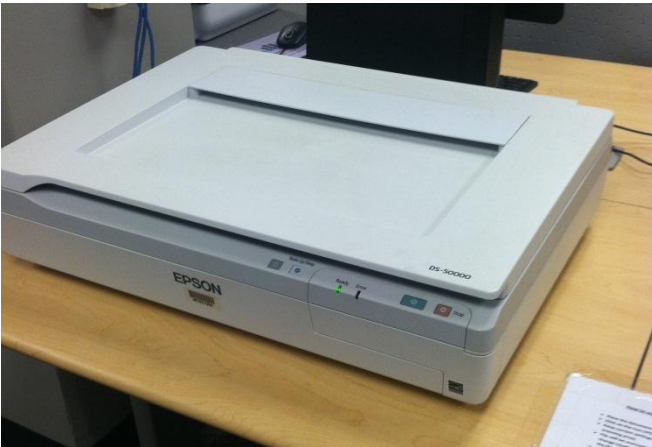

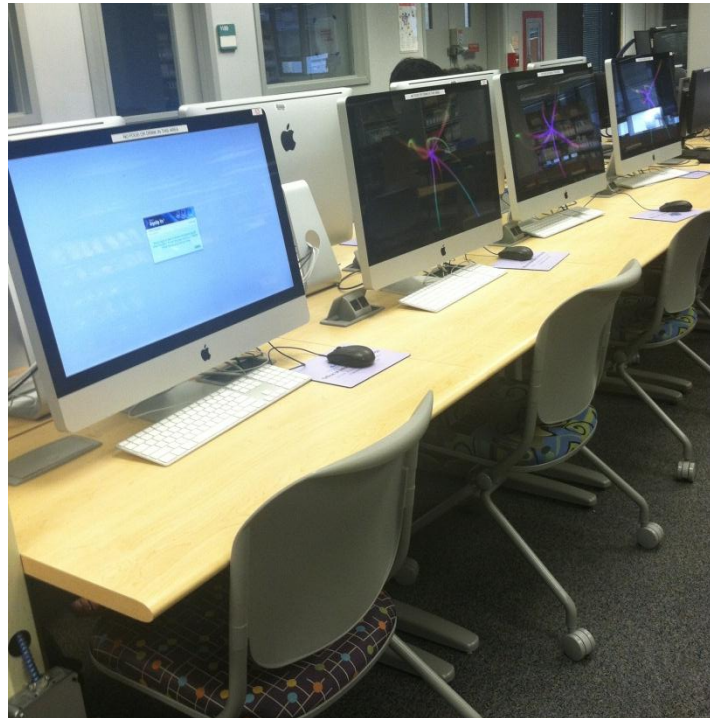


